BBQ Chicken Fundraiser

Monday, 09 April

This **mandatory event** helps raise the largest amount of funds for the ASP trip. This year each ASP applicant will only earn funds based on the number of hours they individually work; to be credited specifically toward their ASP trip balance. Parent hours will be credited towards their student, but cannot work en-lieu of the student. Funds will only be disbursed between the ASP and HAITI Mission Teams' participants.
